



How To Prepare Your Home For Siding Installation

The customer experience is a top priority at Power Home Remodeling Group. Please find a few requests to better prepare for your upcoming installation.

- Please trim back trees and shrubs and move all lawn ornaments, garden hoses, storage boxes, patio furniture, planters, hanging plants etc. within work areas.
- Power will remove all hooks, hangers, flag pole brackets, house numbers, mailboxes, etc. They will be re-installed upon request.
- If Power is removing lights off your walls, you can purchase new ones prior to the installation, and Power will reinstall them as long as the baseplate is the same size. If the baseplates are larger, this must be noted at the Pre-install Inspection.
- All shutters in the work areas will be removed and disposed of unless otherwise noted in the work specification form.
- Please keep a close eye on all pets.
- Power will note the delivery location of project materials on your property. Please keep all vehicles away from this area.
- All electrical meters and service cables will be addressed at Pre-install Inspection.

- Please remove all interior pictures, paintings and collectibles including contents in cabinets next to exterior walls.
- Please make sure there is an operational outside outlet. If you do not have one, we will discuss another option for power.
- The installation process involves a lot of nailing into the exterior walls of your home. This may cause interior nail pops or tile damage. These potential challenges are not Power's responsibility.
- If you have a satellite dish on your wall, we will need to remove and reinstall it. Please contact your satellite carrier to realign your dish.
- If we need a dumpster, we will discuss the location of its placement with you to ensure it doesn't interfere with access to your home.
- Any issues with work area not covered on our work specification form will be addressed at the Pre-install Inspection.
- Any extra materials that are left over will be returned to our warehouse.
